Have:

- Minimal sight lines looking in
- Fenced and/or hard to access

Why:

- Harder to survey what's there
- Harder to get in & out undetected

Have:

- Open sight lines
- Easily visible driveway or camera access

Why:

- Too much greenery allows for hiding spots & harder to spot things are amiss
- Camera - real or dummy - can create a deterrent



Vehicle



Have:

- Locked; Keys not accessible
- Clean, No visible Valuables & Clear of Snow
- Out of season vehicles covered
- Within sightlines

Why:

- Harder to access
- Less Attractive

Have:

- Closed as often as possible
- Double check to make sure it closes fully
- Locked door between house & garage, especially at night

Why:

- Harder to survey what's there

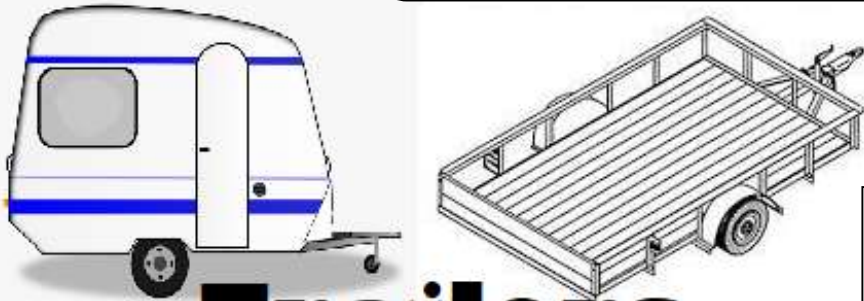

Trailers

- Have:**
- Parked where its inconvenient to access
 - Blocked in by another vehicle
 - Trailer locks, wheel chock locks
- Why:**
- Harder to access & Less Attractive

- Have:**
- Left on at night or on a motion sensor
 - Additional light(s) along driveway or in yard
- Why:**
- A lit up area can be more of a deterrent – easier to spot

- Have:**
- Dog Alerting To Anything Outside
 - Work Vehicle blocked in, inconvenient to access, within sightlines & well lit area
- Why:**
- A possible deterrent
